Huhtamaki TP is committed to avoiding the purchase of forest-based materials which have originated from controversial sources and to ensuring that the company is not directly or indirectly associated with any of the following unacceptable activities:

- Illegal harvesting or illegal trade in forest products.
- Violation of customary or human rights within the forestry or forest products sector.
- Violation of workers' rights and principles defined in the International Labour Organisation (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work within the forestry or forest products sector.
- Destruction of High Conservation Values in forests or High Conversion Value areas.
- Conversion of natural forest cover.
- Use of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations for any other purposes than research.

Huhtamaki TP also apply the core labour requirements as evidenced in the Chain of Custody Certification standard FSC-STD-40-004 which is based on the ILO Core Conventions Principles.
